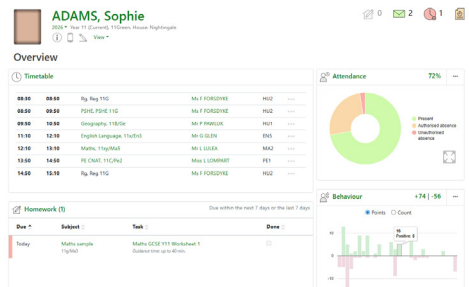

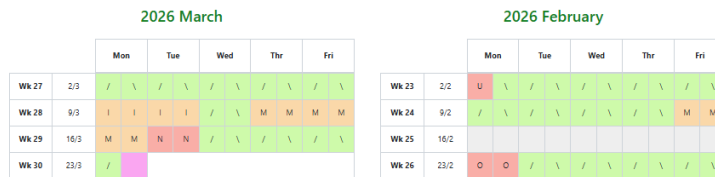

Parental communication

Timely updates about attendance help address absence quickly and support improved attendance outcomes. Regular messages about behaviour encourage meaningful dialogue between home and school, helping to reinforce positive habits and address concerns early. Homework reminders keep students organised and accountable, while updates about school events and trips help families stay connected to the wider curriculum.

GO 4 Schools' parental engagement tools make this communication seamless. The parental portal gives families real-time insight into how well their child is progressing, while a range of communication options—including email, mobile app notifications, and text messages—ensures important information is delivered promptly and in the format that suits your community best. Keeping parents well informed fosters purposeful dialogue, strengthens support for school policies, and helps build a culture of respect and shared responsibility.

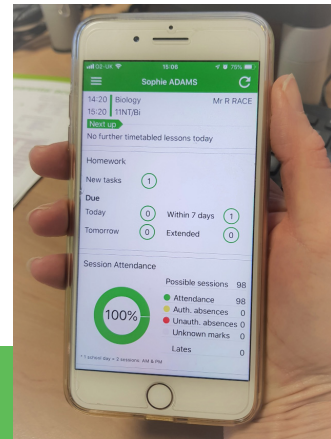

Key module benefits

- Control which headline grades (baseline, target, current, etc) you share with parents and which are for school-use only.
- Allow parents to access their child's school timetable online, to help ensure students come to school properly equipped for the day.
- Publish progress reports online, and receive read-receipts when parents view them.
- Share summary attendance data from your MIS or detailed attendance data with the Online attendance module.
- Share summary behaviour data from your MIS or detailed behaviour data with the Online behaviour module, which can also send daily/weekly notifications to parents.
- Control the subjects for which parents can see assessment data, and the level of detail they can see with the Online markbooks module.
- Use the Online homework module to help parents access homework details and support students' independent learning.
- Parents can notify the school about changes to their addresses and phone numbers online.
- GO 4 Schools provides parents with user accounts based on the data already in your MIS, and handles the issuing of passwords to them.
- Online inbox for parents to view all email communication sent from the school regarding attendance, behaviour, detentions and homework.
- When used in conjunction with the mobile App is a powerful communication tool between home and school.

What options are there?

- The ability to define your own focus groups for analysis, planning and monitoring interventions.
