# Seating plans

## Preferred data views

Room layouts can be shared between staff to save time, and can be customised for individual lessons.

An overview of staff seating plans can be viewed in GO 4 Schools for quality assurance, used for staff mentoring and for supporting effective student management.

This module is fully integrated with the core GO 4 Schools system and is not a stand-alone product which would require staff to use a different log in, or additional administration for uploading data.

## Create impact in teaching and learning

Effective classroom management and planning improves student outcomes via the use of clear and purposeful Teaching and Learning decisions.

Seating plans in GO 4 Schools inform teachers' decision making and pedagogy by drawing live, up-to-the-minute data from GO 4 Schools instantly, including attainment, behaviour, attendance and focus group data.

Seating plan templates at school, year-group and subject level draw staff to key aspects of school policy and enable the T&L focus to be consistent across all designated areas. This informs the positioning of students in a classroom, to maximise learning potential alongside a deeper understanding of students' learning needs.

Finally, and most importantly, students benefit from more dynamic learning environments based on criteria that have been used by teachers to ensure that students are able to reach their full potential.

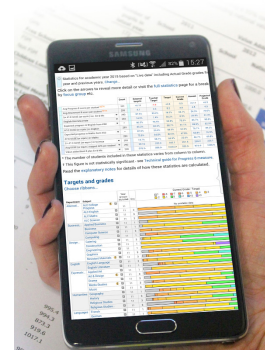
